Hot Weather

Due to the recent hot weather we have made some adjustments to our normal routines and I wanted to let you know about this.

Children will not have to wear ties, may have their shirts untucked and will be encouraged to remove their sweaters.

We have also made adjustments to the curriculum to ensure that children aren't expected to engage in strenuous activity. Our lunchtime team will monitor children over the midday break and if it becomes too hot will bring them in. Teachers have discussed where the shade is and reminded children to reduce physical activity during the heat to reduce overheating.

We have looked at the issue of Sports Day and have decided that we will continue with the event. We may shorten the event if we feel that children are getting too hot. We will also make sure that children have access to unlimited drinks.

What You Can Do

Please ensure that each day, your child arrives at school with sun cream applied. If you feel they need another application during the day send the cream to school, clearly labelled with your child's name. Make sure your child has a sun hat and avoids wearing a sweater. If you are coming to Sports Day please avoid the temptation to bring drinks and snacks. We have found it to be disruptive when parents keep running across the track to check on their child.

The hot weather is predicted to last until Monday when we hope to get back to normal.
