Notice of Proposal to make Prescribed Alteration to River view Community Primary School

Notice is given in accordance with section 19 of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that Salford City Council intends to make a prescribed alteration to River view Community Primary School, 1 Wheaters Street, Off Broughton Road, Salford, M7 1QZ with effect from 1 September 2016.

Salford City Council is proposing:

- (a) Accommodate a new provision for pupils with Autistic Spectrum Conditions (ASC) within the space formerly used as the Children's Centre at River view Community Primary School

- (b) The specialist provision will accommodate up to 6 pupils initially and pupils will need to have a statement of special educational needs' or an Education, Health and Care Plan to be admitted.

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Explanatory Notes

1. There has been a significant rise in the pupil population across the city which has led to increased demand for school places. As part of the increased demand pressure is being felt across specialist provision and there is an identified need for a permanent provision for pupils who have Autistic Spectrum Conditions in Salford.
2. River view Community Primary School has appropriate space that needs very minimal adaptation in which the provision could be delivered.
3. Admissions for pupils will be through the normal admission route for a special school .i.e. via the Local Authority SEN team. Admission will remain at the discretion of the Local Authority and will be for pupils who have an Education, Health and Care Plan or a Statement of Special Educational Needs with their primary need being ASC.
